AGENDA ITEMS

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman: Chief Ledford called the meeting of the Public Safety Urban Area Working Group, June 14, 2012 to order.

Public Safety/EMA

2. QUORUM DETERMINATION

The roll was called by Michelle Norton and it was determined a quorum was in attendance.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

Chief Ledford called for public comments: Ron Kauntz spoke in support of Marine Week.

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4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Chief Ledford asked for a motion to approve the minutes of the May 10, 2012 meeting: Mayor Cicero moved; Chief Zemek seconded; All in Favor; None Opposed.

5. OEM ADMINISTRATOR UPDATE

Walter Topp was introduced as the Office of Emergency Management Administrator. He gave a brief summary of his background which includes experience with Cleveland Police Dept. the U.S. Coast Guard and the U.S. Navy.

6. COMMITTEE REPORTS

AMS - Robert Kollar

Reported on recent port security multi-agency exercise; after-action report being completed. Comment on multi-agency celebration for the bicentennial of the War of 1812 Labor Day Weekend. Cleveland EOC may be used as the unified command center.

Citizen Corps – Sharon Nicastro

Awaiting return of CERT agreements for 2009 funding; remaining balance will offset radio purchase. Reviewing 2010 requests; receipt of a \$12,500 grant will be used for large-scale exercise Feb. 2013.

<u>Communications – Chief Christopher Flynn</u>

Committee met June 13th; discussed future of MotoBridge regarding equipment and updates. Radios procured (799) to be inventoried and distributed. Three seminars will be held for Tactical Interoperable Communications Plan (TICP) and radio training.

EMS - Chief Joseph Zemek

Committee met June 4th; reviewed spending plans, announced upcoming training.

<u>Fire – Chief Mario Bellido</u>

Committee meeting cancelled, no report

<u>Health/Medical – Beth Gatlin</u>

Committee did not meet due to restructuring per Bylaws. Completed the Northeast Ohio Metropolitan Medical Response System (NEOMMRS) Conference June 8. Comment on upcoming National Disaster Medical System (NDMS) exercise, Hotter in Cleveland, July 24-25, requesting volunteers as evaluators, controllers and observers.

Law Enforcement – Chief Scott Lee

Committee did not meet, no report

Public Safety/EMA – Brandy Carney

Tara Vargovich and Serena Steele, from the Office of Emergency Management (OEM), presented information on the Training & Exercise Planning Workshop (TEPW), to be held June 23, 2012 to review the 3-5 year training plan for the County to be reported to the State.

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7. EXECUTIVE SESSION

Chief Ledford stated there will be no Executive Session. He commented on the name and organizational changes for the PS-UAWG. Nora Hurley, Cuyahoga County Law Dept., was introduced and discussed some of those changes for public body meetings in accord with The Ohio Open Meetings Acts. (See handout). 8. PUBLIC SAFETY GRANTS

Paula Young noted all open grants are operating well; working to complete FY2009 which ends August 31, 2012. Comments on the existent audit, inventory of equipment and upcoming site visits. Discussion on FY2012 funding without the UASI grant; FY2012 SHSP is competitive and will focus on sustainment, closing gaps and building new capabilities. Information will be sent to the committees prior to the next UAWG meeting (July 12th); added final project review meeting on (July 19th) location to be determined.

9. ANNOUNCEMENTS / MISC. BUSINESS

Brandy Carney gave an overview of revisions to the Bylaws highlighting changes to membership; open meeting policy for all committees; funding requests; board recommendations and voting. Vallerie Propper noted the name change back to Cuyahoga County Emergency Services Advisory Board (CCESAB), as well as the Conflict of Interest Statement to be revised.
