- HazMat – Nick Zamiska \$200k total
 - Letter to HazMat working group from M. Vedder (See letter attached)
 - Sustain current equipment that expires \$50k
 - Sustainment of training \$50k (Type I)
 - Sustainment of LEPC \$50k
 - Level A suits \$50k
 - HazMat Type I is available and ready to be deployed. Listed with Ohio EMA
 - All four teams that make up type 1 are listed as a type 2
- USAR (Tim Brick and Brian Harting)\$110k total and \$164k total
 - Ohio Response Plan and EMAC deployable
 - Self Sustaining for 72 hrs

- Electrical distribution \$25k
- Training \$25k – Due to drop
- Water distribution - \$25k
- Western Shelter Tent \$35k
- Regional approach to assist Water and HazMat Special Rescue Teams (Pat Sweeney) \$164k total (Paired down to 2 sets of res-com systems at \$26,400 to be bought over a few years, \$60k total)
 - Confined Space equipment to standardize air systems and communications systems
 - Standardized equipment \$94k
 - Communications \$70k
- Water (Mark Bender) \$25k total
 - Deployable asset to region
 - Trailer project almost complete. Seek to have a 2nd trailer in the future
 - \$25k in equipment for sustainment of Regional Type 1 team
- New Business
 - Walter Toff – New administrator for OEM introduction
- Old Business
 - Question from Chief Elliot on behalf of Chief Carroll – Swiftwater Training Class
 - \$10k to be used for swiftwater training is awaiting approval from state. Manual was re-submitted for review. Out of State Homeland FY2010 expires in March. Class needs to be completed by December. (M. Bender)

 - NFPA Standards on Tunnel Rescue
 - Neil Lipsky hired in as safety consultant
