**I. Call to Order / Roll Call**

Mike Herb called the meeting of May 4, 2018 to order. Roll called, and a quorum was in attendance.

**II. Approval of Minutes**

Motion to approve the meeting minutes of January 17, 2018; Chief Foster moved; seconded by Brandy Carney; all in favor; none opposed.

**IV. Old Business**

Mike Herb gave updates on the following projects:

LInX: Federal product is an upper level detective analytical tool for RMS data, which would be connected directly through servers. Three county agencies are currently testing the product. Sheriff’s Dept. is in the planning phase City of Cleveland is conducting legal review. Explanation on data connection, agency access and expansion.

Data Warehouse:

Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for the data warehouse will be completed to send to agencies next week, with focus on data sharing and system access. Noted the data warehouse system is built-out and importing TAC data at this time. Adding ALPR data. Test users have had positive interaction with the system. It will update every 24 hours for purges and expungements. Working on adding non-confidential supplemental narrative information to the system.

Protection Order: Dept. of Justice grant; design and build moving forward; LEADS approval to test. Service and support will be provided by Chagrin Valley Dispatch, buildout assistance with a local vendor. Courts will have ability to login to the system enter and delete protection orders. Law enforcement will receive live scan of the orders for validity. Direct import into LEADS. Update on RMS vendor contracts and connections to the system.

Additional:

Securus (Jail Management System): Coordinating statement of work and deliverables, to move forward with contract.

ALPR: Approved for mobile LPR software support purchase, \$5.00 fee funded.

Fixed LPR's: 95% installed and operative, spread throughout the county. Map of locations to be provided.

Commented on Jewish Community Federation's (Beachwood) camera purchase, compatibility with county LPR systems and increased data feeds to share. They would like to purchase additional cameras through private funding.

Update on county mobile camera trailers. Plans to put out RFP to purchase additional.

Discussion on presentations to law enforcement agencies and user trainings for the systems; contact Mike Herb for presentations, trainings-Chagrin Valley Dispatch. Interactive forms located on CVD webpage.
